"And it came to pass that night, that the angel of the LORD went out, and smote in the camp of the Assyrians an hundred fourscore and five thousand: and when they arose early in the morning, behold, they were all dead corpses. So Sennacherib king of Assyria departed"

After reading this I thought about how the devil still sends his letters today. It might come telling you that your finances are gone and how on earth are you going to be able to make your house payment? You know there are several people that have been foreclosed on and you are next. Or it might be telling you that everybody who has had your sickness has died—remember Bro. or Sis. So and So? The Hem of His Garment (continued from front cover)

And it shall be unto you for a fringe, that ye may look upon it, and remember all the commandments of the LORD, and do them; and that ye seek not after your own heart and your own eyes, after which ye used to go a whoring:

That ye remember, and do all my commandments, and be holy unto your God.

I *am* the LORD your God, which brought you out of the land of Egypt, to be your God: I *am* the LORD your God."

After this commandment to wear garment fringes was given, it does not get much discussion in the scriptures. It's easy to miss. But, don't forget its significance, because it shows up again . . . hundreds of years later, on the shores of Galilee.

When the Word was made flesh and dwelt among men, He once attended a dinner in a house by the seashore. There must have been quite a crowd gathered there, too. Jairus, the ruler of the local synagogue, came to beg Jesus' help for his dying daughter. He rushed in and dropped imploringly at Jesus' feet.

Jairus' daughter was such a young girl—only twelve years old, just entering the blossom of her life . . . but that life was flickering out. Jesus compassionately arose and accompanied Jairus.

As they went, a certain frail woman drew near. Perhaps she had been lingering at the back of the crowd earlier, bashful to even be there. According to the law, she was ceremonially unclean. She had an issue of blood, and God's law gave specific instructions for her and those near her. (Leviticus 15:19-31) In her case, it was beyond normal. She was diseased. She had been sick and separated from others by this weakening condition for twelve years—just as long as Jairus' dear daughter had been alive. The lady had exhausted her means. She had already spent all that she had and endured the tortures of physicians, but to no avail.

At this moment, as the crowd migrated through town, the needy woman felt her chance. Perhaps she was already jostling amongst the unknowing crowd. Perhaps, Jesus had just passed by her as He went on His life-giving mission. She pressed her way closer and stooping behind Him on a child's level . . . she stretched . . . maybe stumble-stepped and stretched forth again.

"And, behold, a woman, which was diseased with an issue of blood twelve years, came behind *him*, and touched the hem of his garment: for she said, within herself, If I may but touch his garment, I shall be whole." (Matt 9:20-21) According to Strong's Concordance, the Greek word translated "hem" in this passage, and "border" in Luke 8:44, means, specifically, a "fringe" or "tassel."

As the diseased woman stretched forth in faith to reach Jesus, there was the fringed border of His garment . . . swishing amongst the others—a reminder to look upon and remember all the commandments of the Lord. When she reached it . . . Hallelujah . . . she felt it . . . it was done!

And, He felt it, too. How do you stop a crowd? Maybe two or three others had already stepped between them as she straightened to stand. "Who touched my clothes?" A little mumbled conversation and shuffling of feet . . . and then, He was looking straight at her. "And when the woman saw that she was not hid, she came trembling, and falling down before him, she declared unto him before all the people for what cause she had touched him, and how she was healed immediately." (Luke 8: 47) "She told him all the truth." (Mark 5:33)

What did others think? She was unclean. She had touched some of them, and they her. "Daughter, thy faith hath made thee whole; go in peace, and be whole of thy plague." (Mark 5:34) Was it worth it? What a benediction! by Carlos Doolittle

Millions of people in 118 countries are helped by the Salvation Army, founded by William Booth, who was born April 10, 1829.

At age 26, William married Catherine Mumford and together they founded the Christian Mission to minister to the poor, drunk, outcast and wretched on the dirty and dangerous streets of London's East End slums. They fought to end sextrafficking and teenage prostitution in England.

Catherine Booth said: "I felt as though I must go and walk the streets and besiege the dens where these hellish iniquities are going on. To keep quiet seemed like being a traitor to humanity."

William Booth said: "We must wake ourselves up! Or somebody else will take our place, and bear our cross, and thereby rob us of our crown."

William Booth wrote: "What are you living for? What is the deep secret purpose that controls and fashions your existence? What do you eat and drink for? What is the end of your marrying and giving in marriage-your money-making and toilings and plannings? Is it the Salvation of souls, the overthrow of the kingdom of evil, and the setting up of the Kingdom of God? If not, you may be religious ... but I don't see how you can be a Christian."

The most amazing discovery Isaac Newton ever made

Whence arises this uniformity in all their outward shapes but from the counsel and contrivance of an Author?

Sir Isaac Newton died March 20, 1727. Newton stated (as cited in "The Religion of Sir Isaac Newton," Frank E. Manuel, editor, London, Oxford University Press, 1974, p. 112): "And when you are convinced, be not ashamed to profess the truth. For otherwise you may become a stumbling block to others, and inherit the lot of those Rulers of the Jews who believed in Christ, but yet were afraid to confess him lest they should be put out of the Synagogue. Wherefore, when you are convinced, be not ashamed of the truth, but profess it openly and endeavor to convince your Brother also that you may inherit at the resurrection the promise made in Daniel 12:3, that 'they who turn many to righteousness shall shine as the stars for ever and ever.' And rejoice if you are counted worthy to suffer in your reputation or any other way for the sake of the Gospel, for then, 'great is thy reward'!"



IN THE BLINK OF AN EYE

Psalm 6:6

"I am weary with my groaning; all the night make I my bed to swim; I water my couch with my tears."

Every time you blink, you bathe the surface of your eye with a miraculous fluid called tears. Tears are not simply a salty water solution. They are made of water, but also have oils, electrolytes and sticky carbohydrates called



mucins. In addition, they contain antibacterial and antiviral substances. One of these substances is called lysozyme. Any bacteria or virus that finds itself in tear fluid has a 95 percent chance of being dead within ten minutes. That blink of an eye keeps the surface of the eye properly moisturized so that our vision remains clear. Without this moisturization, your eyes would become red and painful, and, if untreated, you would probably go blind. Tear fluid also provides needed oxygen to the surface of your eyes.

But perhaps the most amazing property of tears is even more unexpected. Humans are the only creatures that cry emotional tears. Studies have shown that the ability to produce tears and cry actually helps us cope with emotional situations. There are some

inherited diseases which make people unable to cry tears. Studies have shown that people with this disease cannot deal well with stress.

Tears are a blessing in many ways. But we also remember that God has promised to wipe away all our tears when we reach heaven.

CAN THERE BE DESIGN WITHOUT A DESIGNER?

Romans 1:20a

"For the invisible things of him from the creation of the world are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even his eternal power and Godhead..."

A new science called biomimetics is making news. In the past we have talked about how some of man's designs are often similar to God's which do the same job. However, in biomimetics, researchers actively seek to study the creation to learn of designs that will solve engineering problems.



We are all familiar with the story of how thistle seeds inspired Velcro. Engineers have used the design of the owl's wing to make the structures that carry electrical current to trains. The result is a much quieter ride. The moth's eyes' ability not to reflect light helps make it harder to be spotted by birds. The same design has now been used to make a nonreflective film. The result is a film that can be used to help prevent windows from reflecting light. This film will soon be available commercially. Many dyes are toxic, yet many creatures manage to show off bright colors without using toxic substances. Materials engineers studied how the jewel beetle produces its color. The result is a film that seems to change color depending on the angle from which you view it.

No scientist can offer a rational explanation for how so many thoughtful and efficient designs could be generated in a mindless universe. These designs are fingerprints God left all over the creation so that man might seek Him out.

DARWIN AND HIS FOLLOWERS DRAW THE WRONG CONCLUSIONS

2 Peter 3:6

"Whereby the world that then was, being overflowed with water, perished..."

Charles Darwin once wrote of the fossil record, "No organism wholly soft can be preserved." That's because evolutionary orthodoxy says that fossils are buried and formed by slow, natural processes. In reality, there are many fossils of soft-bodied animals like jellyfish and squid. That is evidence, of course, of rapid, catastrophic burial at the time of the flood. Darwin rejected the flood and therefore got the science wrong.

One fossilized squid, dated 150 million years old by evolutionists, was so perfectly preserved it looked like it could still have ink. Researchers even reconstituted real ink from its fossilized ink sac. The ink, which looks the same as modern squid ink, was even used to draw a picture of the fossil. THE HERO OF THE STORY IS JESUS CHRIST

Persecuted, tortured Christians shares stories of courage and forgiveness While the acts of courage and faith are gripping, Voice of the Martyrs Associate Vice President Jason Peters hopes readers focus on the most important takeaway.

"The hero of the story is Jesus Christ. He gives grace in these situations that we just can't explain from an earthly perspective," said Peters, who adds that believers are able to endure torture and heartache because their hope is not in this world.

"That's the heart of it. The key to all of this is eternal perspective. These brothers and sisters have got an eternal perspective in ways that we can't even begin to imagine," he added.

"They don't have a comfortable existence," Peters said. "Many have been minorities their entire lives. Many of them live in difficult circumstances. In one sense, they've just trained themselves to focus on their eternal reward. In the United States, we get a bit comfortable and it's easy for us not to have an eternal perspective because we're pretty comfortable here."

Some stories of Muslims converting to Christianity may seem unusual, particularly the frequent testimonies of vivid dreams in which Christ appears to them. An Afghan man named John was on his pilgrimage to Mecca when he says Jesus appeared to him in a dream.

Peters admitted that will strike some as odd, but he said the evidence is very strong for these accounts being true.

"It's incredibly frequent," Peters said. "We hear about dreams and visions all the time. I'll be honest with you, I've never had a dream or a vision personally, but I've met those who have. When you hear these stories, it's really hard to deny the fact that it happened."

Peters said Tom Doyle, a fellow Dallas Theological Seminary graduate, has chronicled some of these accounts in his book, "Dreams and Visions." He shared one in particular.

"I remember the story of one guy who said, 'I had a dream. I started to take notes when I would wake up. I make a note of what I heard from this man in white.' And he said, 'Interestingly, I found out later when I ran into a Christian and I shared my notes that it was literally the gospel of John, almost word for word,'" Peters shared.

He believes there's a good reason accounts of dreams and visions are much more common among the persecuted.

"In many of the 68 countries we work in, the Bible is in chains," Peters said. "The Bible is not accessible. We have Bibles everywhere. But when you don't have access to God's word, I believe He works in some miraculous ways."

Peters said God is working in the midst of heavy persecution and is even changing some hearts among the terrorists themselves.

"There was a guy who was coming through Lebanon recently," Peters said. "He was actually teaching jihad to ISIS. He came back transiting through Lebanon. He asked his taxi driver, 'Do you know where I can find a Bible?"

"[The taxi driver] was obviously a little concerned. This fully bearded, rogue teacher of jihad is asking him for a bible. He said, 'I'm sick of the killing,'" shared Peters.

"In the midst of all this evil, everything horrific that ISIS has done, God is drawing people to himself and we're actually seeing many Muslims come to Christ after seeing some of these horrific activities and these brutal actions that ISIS is prosecuting right now," he said.Peters said persecuted believers want all other Christians to know they are prayed for, even in the midst of terrible suffering.

"They want us to pray for them," he said. "They'll often follow that up with, 'And by the way, we're praying for you because we know that you're facing challenges too in your culture."

But it's not all happening through dreams and visions. Joel Richardson

"The vast majority are coming to faith through other faithful Christians sharing the Gospel with boldness," Richardson said. "Rarely is this talked about. There are quiet revivals breaking out in various areas. We here in the West need to get behind what the Lord is doing. We need to support those who are doing their part to bring the Word of God to the Islamic world."

THE 1 SENTENCE THAT STOPPED ROMAN GLADIATOR BATTLES

President Ronald Reagan commented on the Roman Coliseum at the national prayer breakfast, Feb. 2, 1984: "This power of prayer can be illustrated by the story that goes back to the fourth century – the monk (Telemachus) living in a little remote village, spending most of his time in prayer. ... One day he thought he heard the voice of God telling him to go to Rome. ... Weeks and weeks later, he arrived ... at a time of a festival in Rome. ... He followed a crowd into the Coliseum, and then, there in the midst of this great crowd, he saw the gladiators come forth, stand before the Emperor, and say, 'We who are about to die salute you.' And he realized they were going to fight to the death for the entertainment of the crowds. He cried out, 'In the Name of Christ, stop!' And his voice was lost in the tumult there in the great Colosseum. ..."

Reagan continued: "And as the games began, he made his way down through the crowd and climbed over the wall and dropped to the floor of the arena. Suddenly the crowds saw this scrawny little figure making his way out to the gladiators and saying, over and over again, 'In the Name of Christ, stop!' And they thought it was part of the entertainment, and at first they were amused. But then, when they realized it wasn't, they grew belligerent and angry. ..."


Reagan added: "And as he was pleading with the gladiators, 'In the Name of Christ, stop!' one of them plunged his sword into his body. And as he fell to the sand of the arena in death, his last words were, 'In the Name of Christ, stop!' And suddenly, a strange thing happened. The gladiators stood looking at this tiny form lying in the sand. A silence fell over the Colosseum. And then, someplace up in the upper tiers, an individual made his way to an exit and left, and the others began to follow. And in the dead silence, everyone left the Colosseum. That was the last battle to the death between gladiators in the Roman Colosseum. Never again did anyone kill or did men kill each other for the entertainment of the crowd. ..."

Reagan ended: "One tiny voice that could hardly be heard above the tumult. 'In the Name of Christ, stop!' It is something we could be saying to each other throughout the world today."
